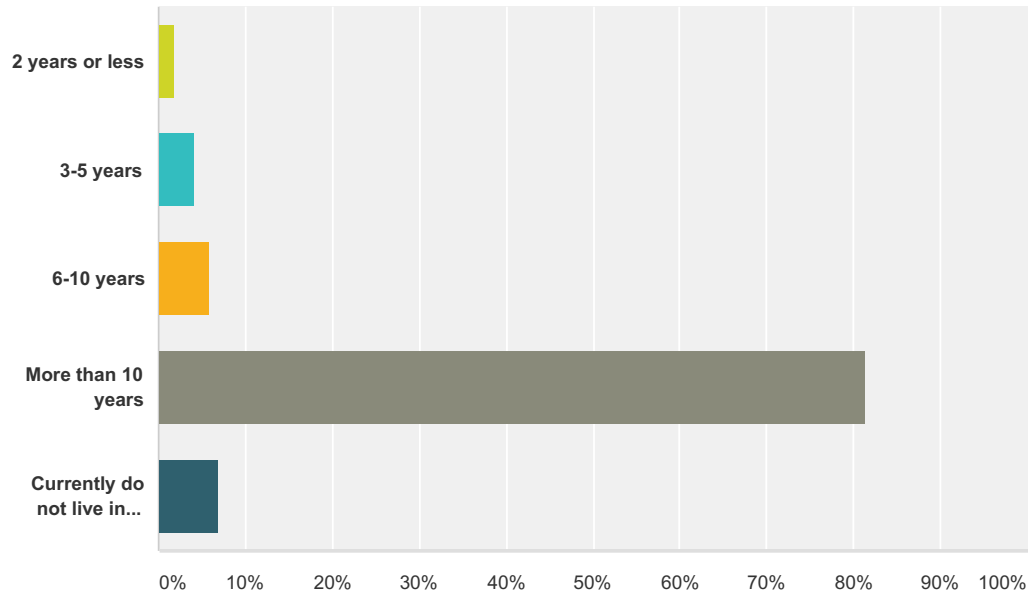


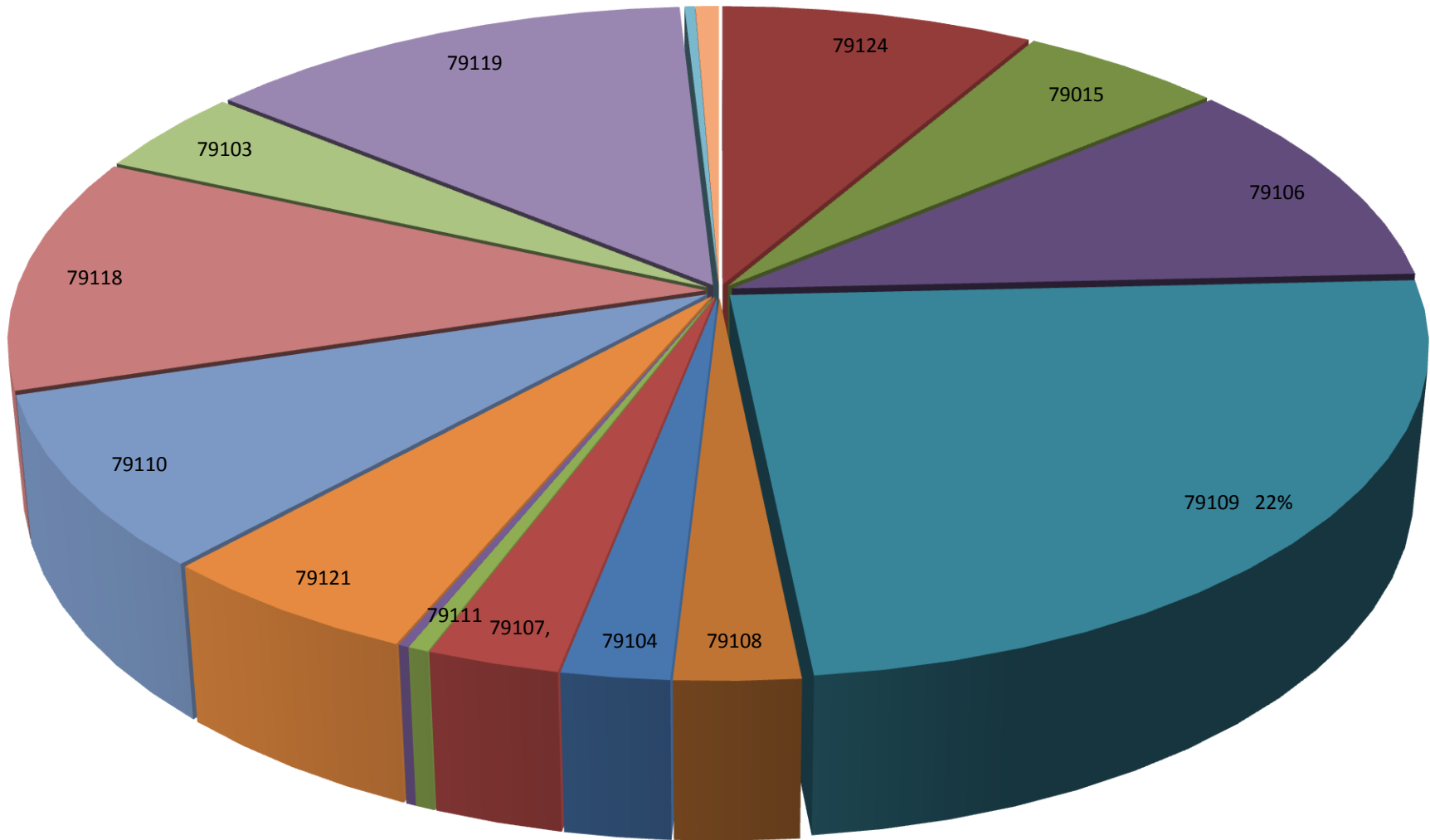
### Q1 How long have you lived in Amarillo?

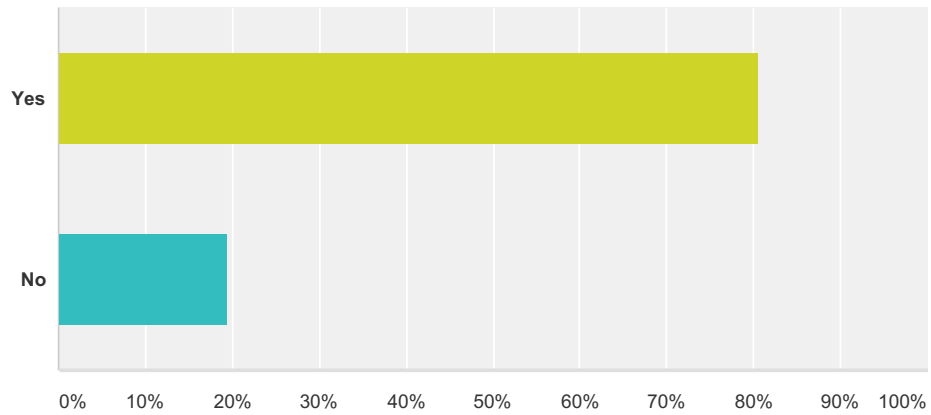

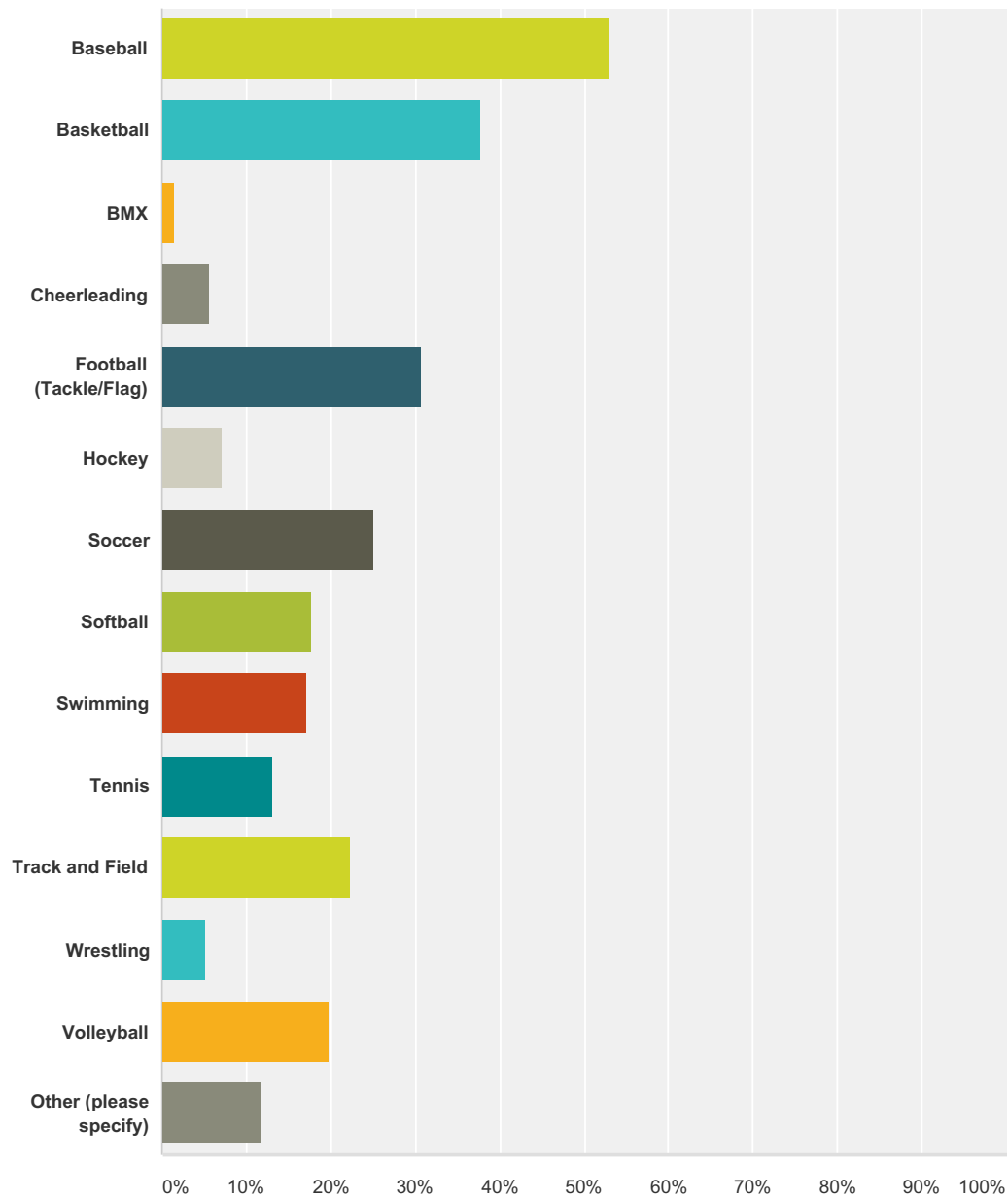

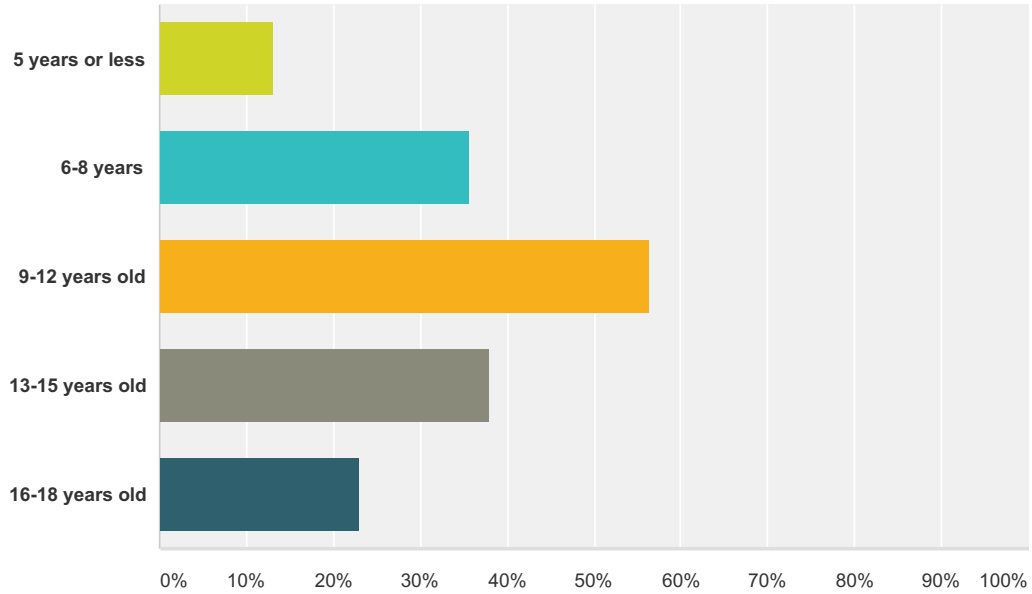

### Q5 What is the age(s) of your child(ren) who currently participate(s) in a youth athletic program?

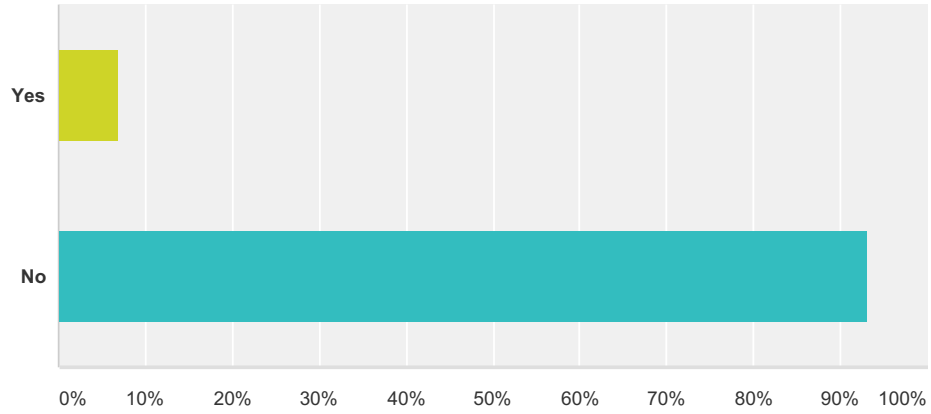

### Q6 Do you feel that the community is currently meeting the demand related to youth athletic programs?

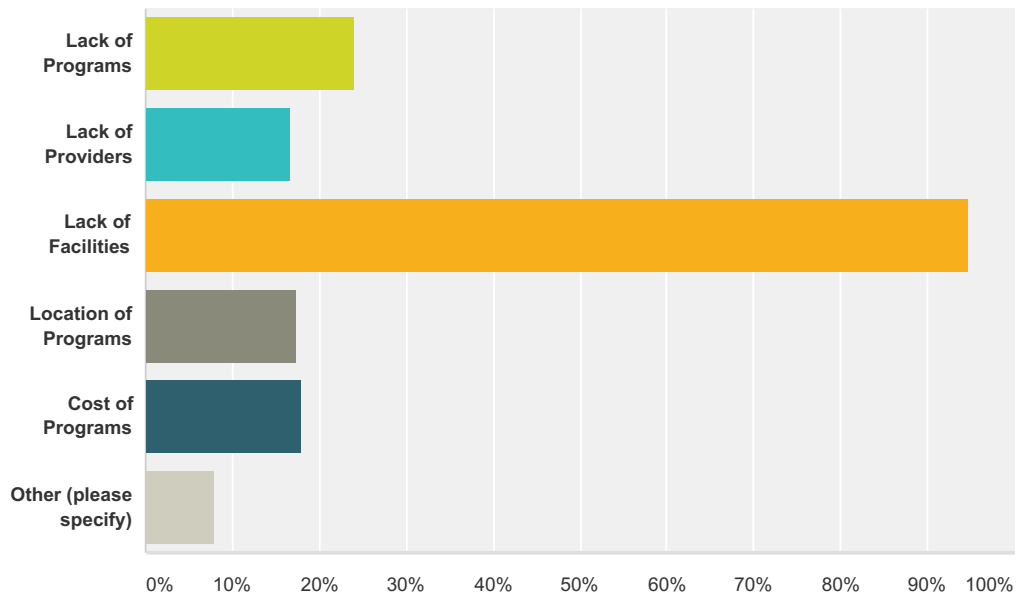

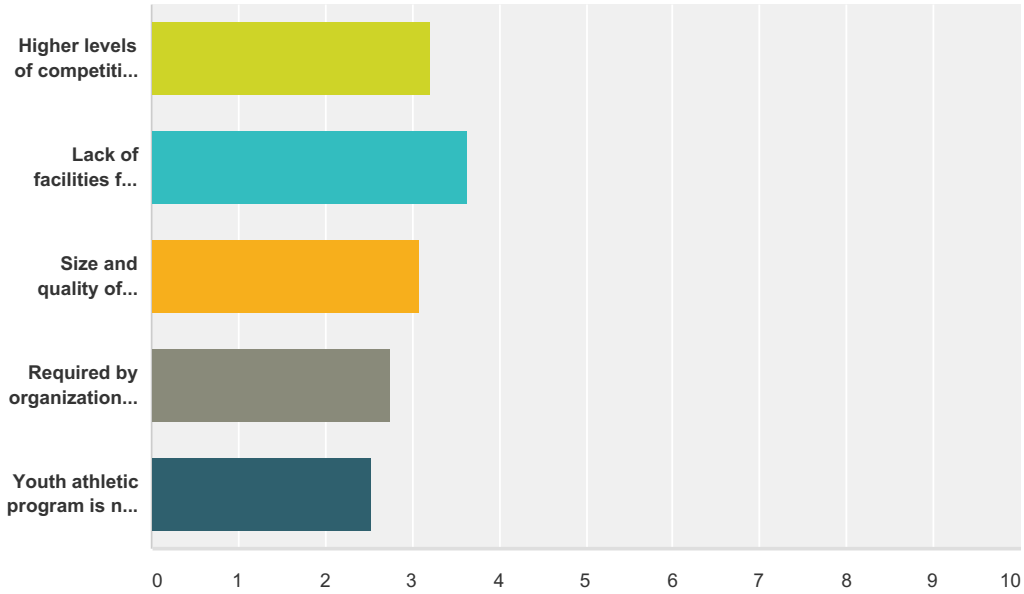

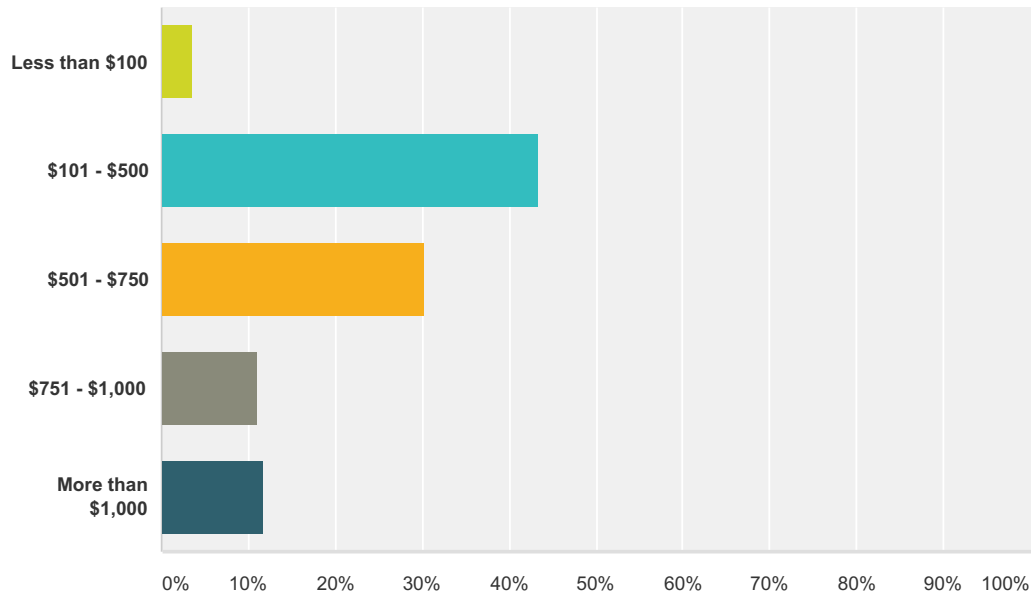

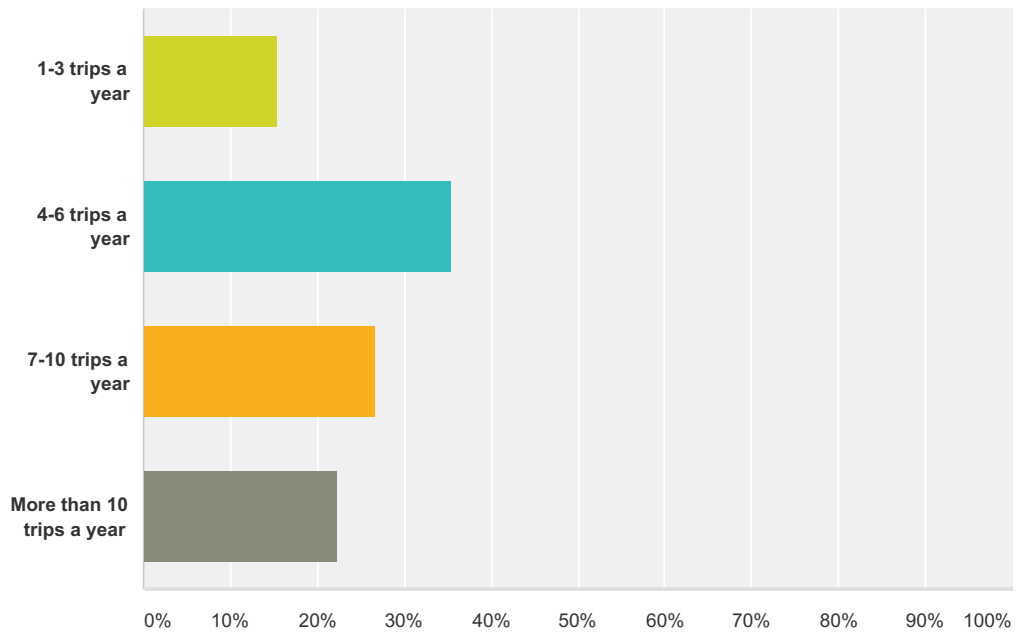

At the start of every season, our kids start behind the eight ball because these other teams have been practicing all summer long. There are kids changing in front of the opposite sex, parents and Civic Center staff. Because of the poor facility, we aren't able to host tournaments like our competitors. We just got back from a tournament in Taos. There were over 20 teams and we stayed three days. Between our hotel, food and entertainment, we spent nearly \$1,000.
